

## Termination of Superintendent & CFO Budget Mismanagement

Overview of Last Year and this Year, Before We Proceed to Next Year's Budget

Our audit for the 2023-24 school year showed that we were 16 million over budget.

Money was moved from our Fund Balance without Board Approval

We come into 2024-2025 School Year with the following scenario:

1st we heard-8 million, therefore we are going to have to have a RIFT

13 million-

16 million-

42 million at least- HIL consultants

Somewhere in all of this mix-a letter was sent on April 21 from the State Auditor saying the district was being investigated. The letter was addressed to the Board Chair, and Superintendent, and later copied to our attorney.

I learned of the letter from social media.

I confirmed with the state auditor that they are working on an investigation of the system finance.

The effects on this community have been devastating. Parents, students, teachers, and staff are going to have to carry this through a RIFT and maybe increase of taxes, which I oppose. Plus our teachers, parents and anyone struggling will feel the effects of this.

I am hearing vendors have not been paid.

I am wondering if we are current on our pension, 401k payment, unemployment insurance

Our CFO was allowed to resign, he should've been terminated.  
Our superintendent should not be allowed to retire, but terminated.

Clearly a breakdown in the governance and we haven't been allowed to provide oversight. We have not been given accurate information.
